EVANGELICAL CHARITY (Formerly Christian Service)

- _____ **Annual Senior Christmas Luncheon:** An event for seniors held in December to bring older parishioners together for the Christmas holiday.
- _____ **Lighthouse (Formerly South Oakland Shelter [S.O.S] Week):** Help raise funds for shelter to be used one week during the month of June, provide food, shelter and support to people who find themselves homeless. As a Family of Parishes event, St. Regis is responsible for 1-2 nights including entertainment and games.
- _____ **Annual Advent Giving Tree:** Help organize and distribute gifts collected for local charities in preparation for the Christmas season.
- _____ **Annual Thanksgiving Food Drive:** Help organize and distribute food collected through the month of November to be distributed to local food pantries.
- _____ **Annual Lenten Acts of Charity:** Help organize and distribute donated items for charities during the Lenten season.
- _____ **St. Vincent de Paul Clothing Drive:** Help collect and organize clothing for Detroit St. Vincent de Paul.

WORSHIP AND LITURGICAL MINISTRIES

- _____ **Funeral Ministry:** Help as sacristans and/or greeters on the day of the funeral.
- _____ **Communion Minister to Nursing Homes or to the Sick:** Bring Holy Communion to one of the area nursing homes and pray with the people; and/or is connected to a specific convalescing person.
- _____ **Ministers of Hospitality:** Assist in greeting, seating, taking up the collection during the weekend Masses, communion, and distributing bulletins. Arrive 15 minutes before the start of Mass and stay for about 5 minutes after the conclusion of Mass.
- _____ **Lectors:** Two lectors are scheduled for each Weekend Mass. Training provided. Scheduled minimum once per month.
- _____ **Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion:** EMHCs assist in distributing Communion during Weekend Mass.
- _____ **Altar Servers:** Open to 4th grade thru adult. Parents are welcome to serve with their children. Training provided.
- _____ **Sacristans:** Mass set-up and clean-up; prepare the vessels for Mass and set up the sanctuary. After Mass, clean the vessels and make sure all is in place in the sanctuary.
- _____ **Music Ministry - Vocalists/Instrumentalists / Cantors:** Prepare and sing with the chorus at 10 a.m. Mass. Help as vocalist/cantor/instrumentalist at other Mass times of choice.
- _____ **Adoration:** Sign up to commit to a particular hour of adoration or to be a substitute for a committed adorer Monday -Friday from 12:30 - 6:30 pm and until 8:30 pm on Tuesdays.
- _____ **Liturgical Environment Committee:** Work with staff to organize and set up indoor and outdoor décor based on liturgical seasons. Assist with taking care of live plants when necessary.
