DRESS CODE AND UNIFORM EXPECTATIONS

We encourage our students to take pride in their uniform. Our dress code fosters the goals of Catholic education by promoting concepts of equality and community in young people. All students must maintain proper school uniform attire, grooming, and etiquette standards required to distinguish a student at St. Regis Catholic School.

All students must follow the dress code apart from preschool students. Please check your child's attire before he or she leaves home each morning. All parents are expected to cooperate in the enforcement of the uniform standards. Deviations from this policy are considered violations of the uniform policy. Administration has the final decision as to what is or is not a violation of the dress code.

Parents will be notified when students fail to comply with the school uniform policy and consequences may include dress-code violations, detentions, and suspensions.

All items may be purchased through Dennis Uniforms, Lands' End, or Educational Outfitters. St. Regis also has a gently used uniform shop called <u>Threads and More</u>.

Traditional Uniform Developmental Kindergarten through Grade 5 – GIRLS

- ✓ Plaid jumper, no shorter than 2.0" above the knee (through Grade 4)
- ✓ Plaid skirt, no shorter than 2.0" above the knee (Grade 5 only)
- ✓ Polo shirt with St. Regis logo (white or red)
- ✓ Long-sleeved polo shirt with St. Regis logo (white or red)
- ✓ White long or short-sleeved button-down shirt with St. Regis logo
- ✓ Button-down or V-neck sweater, or a sweater vest with St. Regis logo (navy or red)
- ✓ Quarter and full-zip fleeces with St. Regis logo (navy or red) can be worn over uniform
- Crewneck sweatshirt with St. Regis logo (red, navy, or grey) can be worn over uniform
- ✓ Pants must be navy, chino type pants (flat front or pleated front is acceptable). Black or navy-blue leggings may be worn *underneath* the skirt or jumper during cold or inclement weather. Leggings must be full length (no crop or capri allowed). Jogger and/or cargo pants are not allowed.
- Dress/knee socks and tights must be solid navy, white, or black. All socks must be visible above the ankle. A simple 'swoop' or symbol (ex. Nike Swoop or Adidas symbol) is acceptable.
- Hair accessories must be solid navy, black, white, red, or matching uniform plaid

- ✓ Pants must be navy, chino type pants (flat front or pleated front is acceptable). Jogger and/or cargo pants are not allowed.
- ✓ A solid navy, black, or brown belt must be worn beginning in **Grade 4**
- ✓ Polo shirt with St. Regis logo (white or red)
- ✓ Long-sleeved polo shirt with St. Regis logo (white or red)
- ✓ Button-down or V-neck sweater, or a sweater vest with St. Regis logo (navy or red)
- ✓ Quarter and full-zip fleeces with St. Regis logo (navy or red) can be worn over uniform
- Crewneck sweatshirt with St. Regis logo (red, navy, or grey) can be worn over uniform
- ✓ Dress socks must be solid navy, white, or black. All socks must be visible above the ankle. A simple 'swoop' or symbol (ex. Nike Swoop or Adidas symbol) is acceptable.

Traditional Uniform Academy (Grade 6-Grade 8) – GIRLS

- ✓ Plaid skirt, no shorter than 2.0" above the knee
- Pants must be khaki, chino type pants (flat front or pleated front is acceptable). Black or navy-blue leggings may be worn *underneath* the skirt during cold or inclement weather. Leggings must be full length (no crop or capri allowed). Jogger and/or cargo pants are not allowed.
- ✓ A solid navy, black, or brown belt must be worn if wearing pants
- Light blue Oxford button-down, long or short-sleeved, uniform brand shirt. Regis logo is optional on oxford shirt. All undershirts must be solid white and without print.
- ✓ Button-down or V-neck sweater, or a sweater vest with St. Regis logo (navy or red)
- Quarter and full-zip fleeces with St. Regis logo (navy or red) can be worn over uniform
- Crewneck sweatshirt with St. Regis logo (red, navy, or grey) can be worn over uniform
- ✓ Dress/knee socks and tights must be solid navy, white, or black. All socks must be visible above the ankle. A simple 'swoop' or symbol (ex. Nike Swoop or Adidas symbol) is acceptable.
- ✓ Hair accessories must be solid navy, black, white, red, or matching uniform plaid

Traditional Uniform Academy (Grade 6-Grade 8) – BOYS

- ✓ Pants must be khaki, chino type pants (flat front or pleated front is acceptable). Jogger and/or cargo pants are not allowed.
- ✓ A solid navy, black, or brown belt must be worn
- Light blue Oxford button-down, long or short-sleeved, uniform brand shirt. Regis logo is optional on oxford shirt. All undershirts must be solid white and without print.
- ✓ A tie or bow tie must be worn (red and blue striped uniform brand)
- ✓ Dress socks must be solid navy, white, or black. All socks must be visible above the ankle. A simple 'swoop' or symbol (ex. Nike Swoop or Adidas symbol) is acceptable.
- Button-down or V-neck sweater, or a sweater vest with St. Regis logo (navy or red)
- ✓ Quarter and full-zip fleeces with St. Regis logo (navy or red) can be worn over uniform
- ✓ Crewneck sweatshirt with St. Regis logo (red, navy, or grey) can be worn over uniform

Gym Uniform Developmental Kindergarten through Grade 8

This uniform is to be worn to school on days students have gym class.

- ✓ Gray t-shirt with St. Regis logo in upper left corner
- Navy shorts (no shorter than 2.0" above the knee)/pants (sweat or warmup material) with St. Regis logo
- ✓ Crewneck sweatshirt with St. Regis logo (red, navy, or grey)
- ✓ St. Regis uniform approved socks
- ✓ A pair of non-marking athletic shoes

Spring/Summer Uniform Developmental Kindergarten through Grade 5

This uniform begins on the first day of school and can be worn through the month of September. Extensions may be made by the administration based on weather and outdoor temperatures. It may be worn again the first Monday in May through the end of the school year.

- ✓ Navy shorts, or skort (flat front or pleated front is acceptable) no shorter than 2.0" above the knee. Athletic and/or cargo shorts are not allowed.
- ✓ Plaid jumper, no shorter than 2.0" above the knee (through Grade 4)
- ✓ Plaid skirt, no shorter than 2.0" above the knee (Grade 5 only)
- ✓ Polo shirt with St. Regis logo (white or red)
- ✓ A solid navy, black, or brown belt must be worn beginning in **Grade 4**.
- Dress socks must be solid navy, white, or black. All socks must be visible above the ankle. A simple 'swoop' or symbol (ex. Nike Swoop or Adidas symbol) is acceptable.

Spring/Summer Uniform Academy (Grade 6-Grade 8)

In addition to our traditional uniform, this uniform can be worn on the first day of school and can be worn through the month of September. Extensions may be made by the administration based on weather and outdoor temperatures. It may be worn again the first Monday in May through the end of the school year.

- ✓ Khaki or chino type shorts, no shorter than 2.0" above the knee (boys and girls). Athletic and/or cargo shorts are not allowed.
- ✓ Plaid skirt, no shorter than 2.0" above the knee
- ✓ Polo shirt with St. Regis logo (white or red)
- ✓ A solid navy, black, or brown belt must be worn.
- ✓ Dress socks must be solid navy, white, or black. All socks must be visible above the ankle. A simple 'swoop' or symbol (ex. Nike Swoop or Adidas symbol) is acceptable.





Shoe Policy Developmental Kindergarten through Grade 8

Below are examples of (boy and girl) shoes that can be worn with the traditional uniform.

- ✓ Dress shoes must be solid navy, brown, or black. No logos.
- ✓ Athletic shoes are to be worn on gym days only. They are not to be worn with traditional uniform.
- ✓ No Ugg-style, Croc-style, open-toed/open-back shoes or flip-flops are permitted.
- Boots are for outdoor use during inclement weather only. Timberlandtype boots are not part of school uniform.
- ✓ Shoes that come with shoelaces must have them in the shoe and not used as slip-ons.





Casual Dress Day Developmental Kindergarten through Grade 8

Casual dress days will be communicated by administration and/or your child's teacher.

- ✓ All shorts, skirts, and dresses must be no shorter than 2.0" above the knee.
- ✓ Shirts must fall below the waistline and be neat and conservative.
- ✓ Jeans and sweatpants **are permitted**.
- ✓ Any shoes listed in the traditional or gym uniform are permitted.
- ✓ Socks are required.
- ✓ **Overall Appearance** guidelines still apply.

Spirit Wear

- ✓ St. Regis spirit wear clothing may be worn on Fridays throughout the school year. This includes but is not limited to: shirts, sweatshirts, pullovers, or anything with St. Regis or 'Raider' on it.

Overall Appearance Developmental Kindergarten through Grade 8

Hair and Personal Grooming

- ✓ Overall appearance should be neat, clean, and well groomed.
- ✓ No hair dye or coloring is permitted.
- ✓ Boys are expected to have their hair trimmed regularly so it is above the ears and eyebrows, and off their neck. Unusual hair cuts or designs cut into the hair are not permitted.
- \checkmark No make up is allowed.
- ✓ Only clear nail polish is allowed. No tips or fake nails are allowed.

Jewelry

- ✓ Girls may wear a wrist watch, small stud earrings, hoop earrings that are no larger than a dime, one bracelet, and/or a religious medal/cross necklace.
- ✓ Boys may wear a wrist watch and/or a religious medal/cross necklace.
- ✓ Smartwatches or any wrist device that connects to a different device is not allowed.
